

CISV San Francisco Bay Area Chapter Village Selection Process - 2019

The Village Selection process includes three parts – submission of a written application, child participation in an overnight Village Mini-camp, and family interviews during the Mini-camp event.

The Application: Both the child and parents complete the required application forms and arrange for two references to be submitted. One reference should be from a current or recent teacher. The second reference can also be from a teacher or from any other adult who knows your child well and can comment on their readiness to participate in the CISV Village program. Both references need to be from people who are not related to the applicant and should be submitted with the application in sealed and signed envelopes. Applications need to include a check for the annual CISV membership fees and the application fee. Families who are current CISV members need to ensure their membership is active.

Village Mini-camp: The overnight Mini-camp is a mandatory part of the selection process that gives potential Village children, Junior Counselors and Leaders an opportunity to meet each other and play CISV games. The focus for the children is on having fun, making new friends and learning more about the CISV organization to explore if the Village experience is something that they would like to pursue. The Mini-camp event is held only once per year in January in support of selection for programs that travel the following summer and winter.

What to bring to Mini-camp: Participants should bring a sleeping bag, pillow, toiletries, pyjamas & a change of clothes for Saturday. Please no cell phones, electronic games or other distractions. Snacks will be served Friday evening, and breakfast and lunch on Saturday. Please let us know about any food restrictions or allergies or other health conditions at the time that you submit your child's application.

Interviews: Parent interviews are set-up near child drop-off or pick-up times from the mini-camp. This gives families an opportunity to discuss CISV with chapter parents who have previously had children participate in CISV Village. Both parents should be available for an interview either Friday evening or Saturday beginning at 10 AM. The parent interview schedule will be coordinated after the applications are received but prior to the event.

Child, Leader and JC candidates will be interviewed during the event. Leader and JC candidates need to prepare and bring a game that they can lead for the group including any supplies that they need to carry out the activity. The game can be a traditional CISV activity or something totally new but needs to be declared and turned in to Carolyn Shavel (cjshavel@msn.com) at least a week ahead of selection. Proposed games will be approved based on suitability to the age group and to assure that there are no duplicates among the leader/JC applicants.
