WRMC (West Regional Mini-Camp) is an annual mini-camp for Junior Branch Members (JBers) from the West Region of CISV USA. If you've never been to a mini-camp before, it is essentially a three-day CISV village; jam-packed with fun CISV activities, top notch educational content, awesome people, energizers galore, and so much more!

The camp is open to participants from the West Region chapters, who are between the ages of 11 and 21, or chaperones who are over the age of 21. JBers from all over the West Region of CISV USA will be coming to participate. The West Region is a region with four official chapters (San Francisco Bay Area, Dallas-Fort Worth, Rocky Mountain Denver and Austin-San Antonio) and one developing chapter (Portland).

Assisted by their NCLD liaison and a couple of fantastic adult representatives from the San Francisco chapter, the West Region JB Presidents have planned a Lion King-themed WRMC that digs into conflict and resolution, one of the four educational content areas of CISV. And we decided there's no better place to have such a camp than in the Redwoods. We're excited to see you in September and show you what we've done!
